Important power points on prayer

1 Corinthians 2:9-12(NKJV) But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." 10 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit...12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

Prayer is...

- Asking God to help us see what he provided for us by grace.
- Agreeing with God and receiving by faith what He has already provided.
 - It is not pressure or begging God – God is motivated to bless us.
- Speaking God's will to be manifest and established on earth and in our lives and the church.
- Most of our praying time should be focussed on
 - Worship & thanksgiving
 - Seeking revelation (opening of spiritual our eyes) to see
 - Agreeing with the Word of God concerning the prayer points
 - Thanking God for protection & provision for family, church, etc.
- Praying in the spirit (tongues) is the highest form of prayer because it is your spirit (the perfect part of you) praying.
- Prayer changes us; it does not change God. We must no limit God with doubt & unbelief (Psalm 78:41)

Remember: You already have it, simply receive it by faith (*Colossians 2:6*)

Understanding Fasting

Fasting is a discipline – that changes you and not God. It is deliberate choice not to eat food or engage in things that in themselves are ordinarily lawful & legitimate, for a spiritual reason. It must include the Word & Prayer! Fasting is not an Old Testament thing; it is a spiritual exercise.

Wrong views about fasting:

- Seeking acceptance or love from God – you are the beloved in Christ!
- Begging or pressure God to move: God has already moved by Grace - only faith pleases God.
- Scoring points before God for answers to prayer

Why we fast and pray?

- Increase our spiritual sensitivity to Holy Spirit leading.
- Free and enlarge our "mental capacity" to receive God's blessings.
- Remove destructive interferences & allows faith to work wonders!
- Discipline the soul (will, mind, emotions, desires, imaginations) – Psalm 69:10

Suggested prayer points: Revelation Knowledge and God's Wisdom

Jeremiah 29:11-12(NKJV) For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. 12 Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.
